She had 13 blood transfusions and 6 plasma transfusions. We spent 2 months in the London's Children's Hospital. She still takes a chemotherapy medicine nightly and a stronger one weekly. She was doing amazing so we thought it was gone and she was in the clear but at her last doctor's appointment we found out that the cancer is back. We were told her best chance is a stem cell/bone marrow transplant unfortunately since she wasn't terminal the government won't pay for it.
